By selecting a JIB company, you are ensuring that companies have a core of directly employed electrical operatives, these workers have been assessed through the Electrotechnical Certification Scheme (ECS) and endorsed by their employer as competent for the level of registration and grade, have met the minimum industry standard for health, safety and environmental awareness, have met the current high assessment standards and regulations for electrical installation work, and are employed under the minimum expected employment standards as recognised by the relevant trade associations and trade unions, often required for large scale public and private works.
